McMurray Art League College Scholarship Application

The McMurray Art League awards a scholarship each year, to a graduating senior of Peters Township High School or a student family member of the McMurray Art League. The student should be planning to attend college or art school in the fall, with the intent to major in one of the following areas: Fine Arts, Art Education, Graphic Design, or Architecture. All eligible applicants are required to supply the following information, which will be kept confidential.

Students must submit this completed application, a portfolio of four to six pieces of finished art completed within the last four years, an artist's statement, as well as two letters of recommendation (see "Requirements" section below). These will be evaluated by the McMurray Art League Scholarship Committee.

The student chosen will receive the Bunky Mosites Memorial Scholarship Award for \$500.00. The recipient must allow one to two pieces of artwork, chosen by the committee, to be photographed for inclusion in the art league newsletter. The student will also receive a one-year membership to the McMurray Art League, which allows them to submit work for any league shows, display work at the Peters Township Library shows, and take discounted classes through the league with local and nationally recognized artists.

Scholarship Requirements

- Please attach two letters of recommendation, including one academic reference. Do not use family members.
- Students must be completing their Senior year of high school with all graduation requirements anticipated to be completed by graduation.
- Students must submit a portfolio of **four to six pieces of artwork, which must be matted or framed. Pieces can include 3D artwork**. All work must have been completed within the last 4 years.
- Any additional work, such as sketchbooks, recognized/awarded artwork, and photo
 journals of additional artwork, are strongly encouraged to be submitted along with
 the portfolio pieces, but not in place of the required artwork.
- An artist's statement must be typewritten and attached to the back of the application.
 It should include where the student intends to attend school and why they chose that
 school, what media the student works in and why they like working in it, as well as any
 other pertinent information that the applicant wants the committee to take into
 consideration.
