## Supplies for plein air painting/ Pastel

This is what I bring no matter what:
Box of pastels
Tripod to hold box
Paper, either mounted on foamcore or clipped to a piece of foamcore
Charcoal stick
Bowl, bottle of water, soft brush for underpainting
Viewcatcher (you can also use your phone or a little piece of cardboard with a rectangle cut into it)
A few old acrylic bristle brushes to brush off mistakes
Kneaded eraser
Kleenex
Gloves
Apron
Hat
Bug spray
Sunblock
I know not everyone will have a tripod/box setup on hand. If you prefer to paint while seated in a picnic shelter, bring a little table easel. You can even sit out in a folding chair or on a park bench with a big towel on your lap & hold your painting on your lap. The towel can hold the pastels you're using.
For the May 18 class session you won't need the last 3 items.
