Materials List:

Good Watercolor paints, Windsor Newton, Daniel Smith or whatever you have. We'll work with it and I'll show you how to mix to get a color needed.

Paint Colors I use: A warm & cool of

- *Lemon yellow. - Cool
- *Cad yellow medium- Warm
- *Cad Orange - warm
- * Cad red light - warm
- *Alizarin Crimson - cool
- *Ultra Marine Blue - cool
- *Cobalt Blue - cool
- *Cerulean Blue - warm
- *Sap green - cool
- *Hookers Green - warm
- *Yellow Ochre - warm
- *Burnt sienna - warm

These are great colors that mix well with one another and are transparent. Cadmium paints are slightly staining but used properly are beautifully transparent by the ratio of water to paint mix.

Container for water

Paper towels

Good watercolor brushes, a brush that has spring to it.

Round Numbers 4,6, 10 or 12

Flat chisel edge 1-4 inch, 1/2 inch if you have it, otherwise 1/4 inch is fine.

Good watercolor paper, I like Arches: # 140 lb. 100% rag
