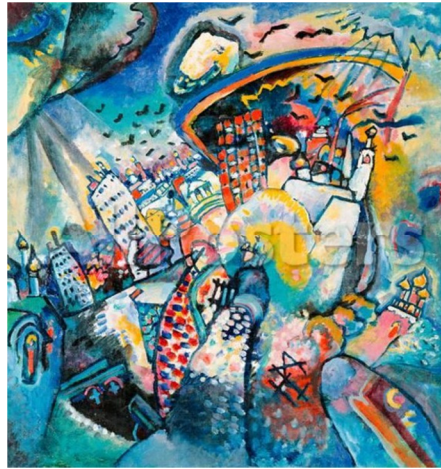

NEXT GENERAL MEETING, Thursday, May 10, 2018 at 7:00 PM

Remember the next meeting is in the evening! After a short business meeting at 7:00, our presenter will be Sandy Conley. Sandy was so moved by the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra's performance of J.S. Bach's *Chaconne*, she committed to visually interpreting this glorious piece of music. The result is **BACH BEREAVED**, a series of 64 related mixed-media paintings depicting the emotion and poignancy expressed by Bach in the *Chaconne*. A 20-minute video was created which pairs a beautiful violin solo rendition of Bach's *Chaconne* with Conley's 64 paintings.

BACH BEREAVED blends and celebrates the multiple artistic disciplines of assemblage painting, music, video and historical story-telling in one substantial project. Conley uses materials in a

unique way to present an assemblage work of art that invites viewers to an up-close inspection. And with the help of talented videographer Dan McKosky and gifted violinist Ellen Chen Livingston, bold images and sublime music seldom heard outside of the concert hall are combined in the unique video presentation. While Bach's *Chaconne* is widely known and appreciated among classical musicians, Conley's goal through **BACH BEREAVED** is to tell the Bach story and to broaden the *Chaconne's* audience and appeal.

Sandy is excited to present **BACH BEREAVED** for the first time in a public setting on May 10th. The original art will be on exhibit, Sandy will describe her process, and show the 20-minute video, **BACH BEREAVED**.
